It is our goal for Susie to have a successful education experience with appropriate social skills, taking her disability into account, to include reasonable accommodations to help her achieve, inside the constraints of that disability. We would like to be active participants in all aspects of her education. This, we believe would help her become more socially acceptable with her peers and produce better grades. OR This, we believe would help her have a more successful education experience.

- 1. For Susie to have preferential seating to eliminate distractions, including test taking.
- 2. We would like for Teaching staff to reduce the density of assigned work to basic ideas to allow her to keep up with the class.
- 3. We would like for teaching staff to help Susie develop and <u>monitor</u> a system for organization.
- 4. For Susie to be given tests and assignments one page at a time, and for the teacher to provide inconspicuous prompts to keep her on track and from having incomplete work.
- 5. We would like for Susie to receive instructions in both oral and written form.
- 6. For Susie to be provided with positive feedback and a system for praise to foster good self esteem.
- 7. We would like teaching staff to check Susie's progress and provide feedback often in the first few minutes of each assignment.
- 8. Provide Susie with an outlet for her hyperactivity, including the ability to use an aid at her desk such as a stress ball, or to get up and move if needed.
- 9. Provide a safe place for Susie when she is experiencing emotional stress, to help her regain control.
